- Ongoing stakeholder and potentially affected property owner engagement on indicative alignment
- Applications for route protection for the Trig Road Upgrade Project and the Redhills North-South and East-West Connections Projects to be prepared.

2020

- Lodge the applications for route protection for the Trig Road Upgrade Project and the Redhills North-South and East-West Connections Projects
- Lodge the resource consent applications for the Trig Road Upgrade Project
- Opportunity for public submissions
- Hearings held for the Projects.
